Transportation is provided in mini-vans, 4WD and sedan cars. When handling a large group, 25-passengers air-conditioned buses are available when tracks to visited areas allow for large vehicles. Otherwise large groups are dispatched onto 4WD for specific segments of the visit.

Depending on the size of the group, we provide a driver plus one or several guides - English, French, German and Spanish. For private or individual FIT's we provide a driver who is also an official guide.

For all our tours, ground arrangements and aircraft handling include shuttle service from/to airports and hotels pickups and sometimes security escort if requested by our VIP clients. Unless otherwise not requested by the client, our itineraries are in full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner). All entry fees, tolls or local taxes (except for airport taxes) are included.
